



Sara & Keith Thompson

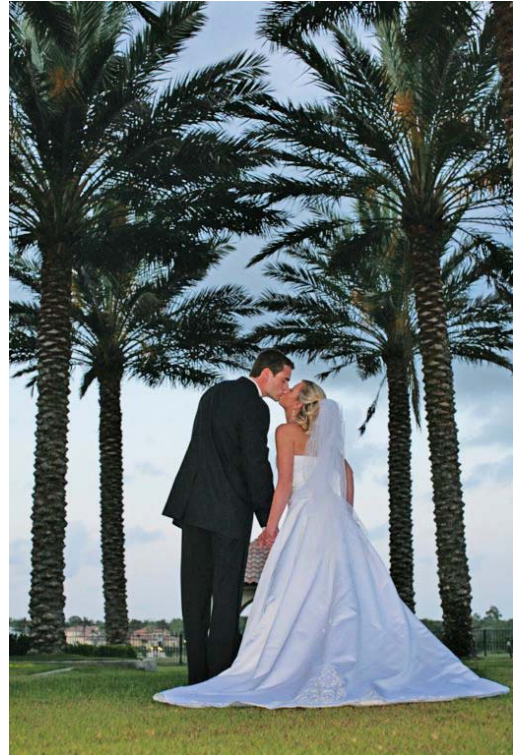
